STANDING IN FREEDOM

GALATIANS 6:15 For in Christ Jesus neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision, **but a new creature.**¹⁶ And as many as walk according to this rule, peace be on them, and mercy, and upon the Israel of God.

ACTS 15:24 Forasmuch as we have heard, that certain which went out from us have troubled you with words, subverting your souls, saying, Ye must be circumcised, and keep the law: to whom we gave no such commandment:

ACTS 15:28 For it seemed good to the Holy Ghost, and to us, **to lay upon you no greater burden than these necessary things;**²⁹ That ye abstain from meats offered to idols, and from blood, and from things strangled, and from fornication: from which if ye keep yourselves, ye shall do well. Fare ye well.

2 CORINTHIANS 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.¹⁸ And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation;

IT IS THE INSIDE THAT COUNTS

GALATIANS 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and **the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.**

IT IS THE INSIDE THAT COUNTS

ROMANS 8:8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.⁹But ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.¹⁰And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.¹¹But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also **quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.**

THE INSIDE NEEDS TO COME OUTSIDE

1 PETER 2:9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light:¹⁰Which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy.¹¹Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul;¹²Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation.
