<sup>19</sup>And by this we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our hearts before Him.<sup>20</sup>For if our heart condemns us, God is greater than our heart, and knows all things.<sup>21</sup>Beloved, if our heart does not condemn us, we have confidence toward God.



**Colossians 3:15** And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.<sup>16</sup> Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.



**John 16:13** “However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.”

**Hebrews 3:10** “Therefore I was angry with that generation, and said, ‘They always go astray in their heart, and they have not known My ways.’<sup>11</sup> So I swore in My wrath, ‘They shall not enter My rest.’”<sup>12</sup> Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God;



**Matthew 11:28** “Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest.<sup>29</sup> Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.<sup>30</sup> For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.”



**Ezekiel 33:30** “As for you, son of man, the children of your people are talking about you beside the walls and in the doors of the houses; and they speak to one another, everyone saying to his brother, ‘Please come and hear what the word is that comes from the LORD.’<sup>31</sup> So they come to you as people do, they sit before you as My people, and they hear your words, but they do not do them; for with their mouth they show much love, but their hearts pursue their own gain.<sup>32</sup> Indeed you are to them as a very lovely song of one who has a pleasant voice and can play well on an instrument; **for they hear your words, but they do not do them.**”



**Psalm 119:9** Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed thereto according to thy word.<sup>10</sup> With my whole heart have I sought thee: O let me not wander from thy commandments.<sup>11</sup> Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.<sup>12</sup> Blessed art thou, O LORD: teach me thy statutes.<sup>13</sup> With my lips have I declared all the judgments of thy mouth.<sup>14</sup> I have rejoiced in the way of thy testimonies, as much as in all riches.<sup>15</sup> I will meditate in thy precepts, and have respect unto thy ways.  
**<sup>16</sup>I will delight myself in thy statutes: I will not forget thy word.**



**1 John 1:8** If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us.<sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.<sup>10</sup> If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us.
