# THE **FACT** OF THE REIGN OF SIN

**Romans 5:12** Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:

**Romans 5:18** Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life.

# THE **FACT** OF THE REIGN OF SIN

1 Corinthians 15:21 For since by man came death, by man came also the resurrection of the dead.<sup>22</sup> For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.



# THE **FACT** OF THE REIGN OF SIN

**Romans 5:13** For until the law sin was in the world: but sin is not imputed when there is no law.<sup>14</sup> Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over them that had not sinned after the similitude of Adam's transgression, who is the figure of him that was to come.




# THE **FACT** OF THE REIGN OF SIN

**Genesis 2:24** Therefore shall a man leave his father and his mother, and shall cleave unto his wife: and they shall be one flesh.



# THE **FEATURES** OF THE REIGN OF SIN


**Romans 5:6** For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.<sup>7</sup> For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die.<sup>8</sup> But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

# THE **FEATURES** OF THE REIGN OF SIN

**Romans 5:10** For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.


**Romans 8:7** Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.<sup>8</sup> So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.






# THE **FEATURES** OF THE REIGN OF SIN

**Romans 1:24** Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves:<sup>25</sup> Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen.<sup>26</sup> For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature:



# THE **FEATURES** OF THE REIGN OF SIN

**Romans 1:27** And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompence of their error which was meet.<sup>28</sup> And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient;



# THE **FEATURES** OF THE REIGN OF SIN

**Romans 1:29** Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers,<sup>30</sup> backbiters, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents,




# THE **FEATURES** OF THE REIGN OF SIN

**Romans 1:31** Without understanding, covenantbreakers, without natural affection, implacable, unmerciful:<sup>32</sup> Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but **have pleasure in them that do them.**



# THE **FEATURES** OF THE REIGN OF SIN

**Romans 5:18** Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life.<sup>19</sup> For as by one man's disobedience **many** were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall **many** be made righteous.

# THE **FEATURES** OF THE REIGN OF SIN

**Romans 10:9** That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.<sup>10</sup> For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.<sup>11</sup> For the Scripture says, “Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame.”<sup>12</sup> For there is no distinction between Jew and Greek, for the same Lord over all is rich to all who call upon Him.<sup>13</sup> For “whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.”
