

Isaiah 43:22 But thou has not called upon me, O Jacob, but thou has been weary of me, O Israel.23Thou hast not brought me the small cattle of thy burnt offerings; neither hast thou honored Me with thy sacrifices. I have not caused thee to serve with an offering, nor wearied thee with incense.24Thou has brought me no sweet cane with money, neither has thou filled me with the fat of thy sacrifices; but thou has made me to serve with thy sins, thou hast wearied me with thine iniquities. ²⁵I, even I, am He that blotteth out thy transgressions for mine own sake, and will not remember thy sins.

THE PROBLEM: SUPERFICIAL SERVICE

Isaiah 43:22 "But you have not called upon Me, O Jacob; and you have been weary of Me, O Israel.²³You have not brought Me the sheep for your burnt offerings, nor have you honored Me with your sacrifices. I have not caused you to serve with grain offerings, nor wearied you with incense.24You have bought Me no sweet cane with money, nor have you satisfied Me with the fat of your sacrifices; but you have burdened Me with your sins, you have wearied Me with your iniquities."

THE PROBLEM: SUPERFICIAL SERVICE

Psalm 122:1 I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the LORD.

Psalm 84:2 My soul longs, yes, even faints for the courts of the LORD; my heart and my flesh cry out for the living God.³Even the sparrow has found a home, and the swallow a nest for herself, where she may lay her young—even Your altars, O LORD of hosts, my King and my God.⁴Blessed are those who dwell in Your house; they will still be praising You. Isaiah 43:11 "I, even I, am the Lord, and besides Me there is no savior."

Isaiah 43:25 "I, even I, am He who blots out your transgressions for My own sake; and I will not remember your sins."

THE SOLUTION: THE SATISFYING SAVIOR

Isaiah 53:4 Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted. ⁵But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned, every one, to his own way; and the Lord has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.

Revelation 2:4 "Nevertheless I have this against you, that you have left your first love.

5Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place—unless you repent."

Isaiah 43:26 "Put Me in remembrance; let us contend together; state your case, that you may be acquitted."
