A MOMENT OF DECISION

Exodus 2:11 Now it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown, that he went out to his brethren and looked at their burdens. And he saw an Egyptian beating a Hebrew, one of his brethren.12So he looked this way and that way, and when he saw no one, he killed the Egyptian and hid him in the sand. 13 And when he went out the second day, behold, two Hebrew men were fighting, and he said to the one who did the wrong, "Why are you striking your companion?"14Then he said, "Who made you a prince and a judge over us? Do you intend to kill me as you killed the Egyptian?" So Moses feared and said, "Surely this thing is known!"

Exodus 2:10 And the child grew, and she brought him to Pharaoh's daughter, and he became her son. So she called his name Moses, saying, "Because I drew him out of the water."

Acts 7:20 "At this time Moses was born, and was well pleasing to God; and he was brought up in his father's house for three months.21But when he was set out, Pharaoh's daughter took him away and brought him up as her own son.22 And Moses was learned in all the wisdom of the Egyptians, and was mighty in words and deeds."

Hebrews 11:23 By faith Moses, when he was born, was hidden three months by his parents, because they saw he was a beautiful child; and they were not afraid of the king's command.24By faith Moses, when he became of age, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter,25 choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin,26esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt; for he looked to the reward.

Acts 7:23 "Now when he was forty years old, it came into his heart to visit his brethren, the children of Israel.24And seeing one of them suffer wrong, he defended and avenged him who was oppressed, and struck down the Egyptian."
