Exodus 4:18 So Moses went and returned to Jethro his father-in-law, and said to him, "Please let me go and return to my brethren who are in Egypt, and see whether they are still alive." And Jethro said to Moses, "Go in peace."¹⁹ And the LORD said to Moses in Midian, "Go, return to Egypt; for all the men who sought your life are dead."²⁰ Then Moses took his wife and his sons and set them on a donkey, and he returned to the land of Egypt. Exodus 4:21 And the LORD said to Moses, “When you go back to Egypt, see that you do all those wonders before Pharaoh which I have put in your hand. But I will harden his heart, so that he will not let the people go.²² Then you shall say to Pharaoh, ‘Thus says the LORD: “Israel is My son, My firstborn.²³ So I say to you, let My son go that he may serve Me. But if you refuse to let him go, indeed I will kill your son, your firstborn.”’”

— MOSES AND AARON —

Exodus 4:27 And the LORD said to Aaron, “Go into the wilderness to meet Moses.” So he went and met him on the mountain of God, and kissed him.²⁸ So Moses told Aaron all the words of the LORD who had sent him, and all the signs which He had commanded him.²⁹ Then Moses and Aaron went and gathered together all the elders of the children of Israel.



1 Chronicles 23:15 The sons of Moses were, Gershom, and Eliezer.¹⁶ Of the sons of Gershom, Shebuel was the chief.¹⁷ And the sons of Eliezer were, Rehabiah the chief. And Eliezer had none other sons; but the sons of Rehabiah were very many.



1 Chronicles 26:24 And Shebuel the son of Gershom, the son of Moses, was ruler of the treasures.²⁵ And his brethren by Eliezer; Rehabiah his son, and Jeshaiiah his son, and Joram his son, and Zichri his son, and Shelomith his son.²⁶ Which Shelomith and his brethren were over all the treasures of the dedicated things, which David the king, and the chief fathers, the captains over thousands and hundreds, and the captains of the host, had dedicated.²⁷ Out of the spoils won in battles did they dedicate to maintain the house of the LORD.²⁸ And all that Samuel the seer, and Saul the son of Kish, and Abner the son of Ner, and Joab the son of Zeruah, had dedicated; and whosoever had dedicated any thing, it was under the hand of Shelomith, and of his brethren.
