THE SONG OF MOSES

Deuteronomy 31:16 And the LORD said to Moses: "Behold, you will rest with your fathers; and this people will rise and play the harlot with the gods of the foreigners of the land, where they go to be among them, and they will forsake Me and break My covenant which I have made with them."

Deuteronomy 31:22 Therefore Moses wrote this song the same day, and taught it to the children of Israel.



Psalm 90:10 The days of our years are threescore years and ten; and if by reason of strength they be fourscore years, yet is their strength labor and sorrow; for it is soon cut off, and we fly away.

Psalm 90:12 So teach us to number our days, that we may apply our hearts unto wisdom.



2 Thessalonians 2:1 Now, brethren, concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our gathering together to Him, we ask you,² not to be soon shaken in mind or troubled, either by spirit or by word or by letter, as if from us, as though the day of Christ had come.³ Let no one deceive you by any means; for that Day will not come unless the falling away comes first, and the man of sin is revealed, the son of perdition,



1 Timothy 4:1 Now the Spirit expressly says that in latter times some will depart from the faith, giving heed to deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons,



— THE RIGHTEOUSNESS OF THE ROCK —

Deuteronomy 32:3 For I proclaim the name of the LORD: Ascribe greatness to our God.⁴ He is the Rock, His work is perfect; for all His ways are justice, a God of truth and without injustice; righteous and upright is He.



— THE REJECTION OF THE ROCK —

Deuteronomy 32:15 “But Jeshurun grew fat and kicked; you grew fat, you grew thick, you are obese! Then he forsook God who made him, and scornfully esteemed the Rock of his salvation.¹⁶ They provoked Him to jealousy with foreign gods; with abominations they provoked Him to anger.¹⁷ They sacrificed to demons, not to God, to gods they did not know, to new gods, new arrivals that your fathers did not fear.¹⁸ Of the Rock who begot you, you are unmindful, and have forgotten the God who fathered you.”

— THE REALITY OF THE ROCK —

Deuteronomy 32:28 “For they are a nation void of counsel, nor is there any understanding in them.²⁹ Oh, that they were wise, that they understood this, that they would consider their latter end!³⁰ How could one chase a thousand, and two put ten thousand to flight, unless their Rock had sold them, and the LORD had surrendered them?³¹ For their rock is not like our Rock, even our enemies themselves being judges.”



— THE REALITY OF THE ROCK —

Deuteronomy 32:40 “For I raise My hand to heaven, and say, ‘As I live forever,⁴¹ if I whet My glittering sword, and My hand takes hold on judgment, I will render vengeance to My enemies, and repay those who hate Me.⁴² I will make My arrows drunk with blood, and My sword shall devour flesh, with the blood of the slain and the captives, from the heads of the leaders of the enemy.’⁴³ Rejoice, O Gentiles, with His people; for He will avenge the blood of His servants, and render vengeance to His adversaries; He will provide atonement for His land and His people.”



Deuteronomy 31:28 “Gather to me all the elders of your tribes, and your officers, that I may speak these words in their hearing and call heaven and earth to witness against them.²⁹ For I know that after my death you will become utterly corrupt, and turn aside from the way which I have commanded you. And **evil will befall you in the latter days**, because you will do evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke Him to anger through the work of your hands.”
